

Suggestions For Amendment of WTC Constitution

Draft clauses

Trustees

- The Trustees must be elected by the Committee to hold office until death or resignation unless removed from office by resolution of the Committee.
- The number of Trustees must not be more than 4 or less than 2.
- The property of the Club must be vested in the Trustees except for cash which must be under the control of the Treasurer.
- The Trustees must deal with the property of the Club as directed by resolution of the Committee and an entry in the Minute Book is conclusive evidence of a resolution.
- The Trustees may be indemnified against risk and expense out of the Club property.

Expulsion of Members

- The Committee may expel any Member who offends against the Rules of the Club or whose conduct in the opinion of the Committee renders him unfit for membership of the Club.
- Before any Member is expelled the Secretary must give him 7 days written notice to attend a meeting of the Committee must inform him of complaints made against him.
- No Member may be expelled unless:
 - he is first given an opportunity of appearing before the Committee and answering the complaints made against him; and
 - at least two-thirds of the Committee then present vote in favour of his expulsion.
- In the event of expulsion of the Member will forfeit all subscription paid with current term of membership and all claims upon or rights to the Club and its property.

Sub – Committees

- There shall be a Selection Committee, and this will consist of three members elected at the Annual General Meeting plus the current captains of the Mixed Doubles teams. The Committee shall have the power to elect Captains as required
- The Committee may from time to time as it considers necessary or expedient appoint Sub-Committees from among its members and may depute or refer to them any of its powers and duties.
- The Sub-Committees must periodically report their proceedings to the Committee and must conduct their business in accordance with the directions of the Committee.
- If any Member of a Sub-Committee ceases to be a Member of the Committee he automatically ceases to be a Member of the Sub-Committee and another elected Member of the Committee must be appointed in his/her place.
